University and College Requirements

- Writing Requirement - The University requires that a candidate for graduation must have completed two designated writing credit courses at USA, with at least one course chosen from offerings in the candidate's major or minor. Courses meeting this requirement are designated with a ( $W$ ) after the course title in the "Courses" section of the University Bulletin. Individuals who transfer in credit to substitute for a course(s) designated as a (W) course must meet the writing requirement by taking a (W) course(s) at USA.
- Transient Approval - Students must have prior approval (obtained in the Advising Center) to enroll as a transient student at another institution. A maximum of 60 semester hours (or $50 \%$ of total hours required for the program) may be accepted from a two-year institution.
- Residency Requirement - A candidate for graduation must complete a minimum of 25 percent of the credit hours required for the degree through instruction offered by the University of South Alabama in upper-division course work ( 300 and 400 levels).
- LiveText Assessment-The College of Education uses student portfolio assessment as a part of program requirements and assessment of student learning outcomes. Students majoring the College of Education are required to purchase the license to use LiveText beginning with the first College of Education course (which contains teacher education standards) taken and continue to use the software throughout their program of study. ## Teacher Candidacy Admission Requirements for ELEMENTARY-EDK6 Majors in Leadership and Teacher Education

## Hours:

- 60 program hours. A minimum of $\mathbf{1 2}$ semester hours must be taken at USA.

GPA Requirements:

- 2.50 Minimum Overall GPA (All work attempted at USA.) (2.50 Minimum Overall GPA required for graduation/certification.)
- 2.50 Minimum Program GPA (All courses used on this Advising Sheet, including transfer work.)
- 2.50 Minimum Professional Studies GPA (All courses used in the Professional Studies area, including transfer work.)
- 2.50 Minimum Teaching Field GPA (All courses used in the Teaching Field, including transfer work.)
- No grade below a "C" will be accepted in the $4 \times 12$, the Professional Studies or Teaching Field courses.
- D, F or U grades earned in Candidacy courses will result in removal from Candidacy.

Course Requirements:

- $4 \times 12$ : Completion of the following courses are required of K-6 Elementary, Early Childhood, Collaborative K-6 and 6-12, Early Childhood Special Education certification - 12 semesters hours in each of the four areas: English/Language Arts, Math, Science, Social Science with a grade of C or better.
- CA 110, EH 101, EH 102, EDM 310, EPY 351 EDU 330 and EDU 346, including the ePortfolio assessment, in these courses.

Other requirements:

- Proof of clear SDE fingerprinting/background check and professional liability insurance.
- Completion of a satisfactory departmental interview with your assigned advisor. Recommendation of advisor and department chairperson.
- Sufficient physical ability and emotional stability to perform as a teacher.

Application/Admission Information:

- Candidacy applications are required one semester prior to enrolling in classes that require Candidacy. The intent is for students to apply for Candidacy AND meet with their advisor prior to registration to enable appropriate planning decisions for upcoming semesters.
- Students approaching eligibility will receive a link to the online application in their JagMail.
- After final grades are posted and all requirements are verified as met, the Office of Student Services will notify students by JagMail when they are admitted to Candidacy. Students will then be able to register for Candidacy courses.

Teacher Candidacy Course Enrollment:

- Courses in Teacher Candidacy for Elementary Education are grouped into three consecutive semesters - Tier 2, Tier 3, and Tier 4
- The Graduation Plan in the Bulletin details the specific courses in each Tier that must be taken together. All courses listed in a single Tier must be completed in the same semester.
